Devar Torah by Yirmy Ertel:

In this weeks Parsha of Parshas Noach, there are 153 verses. They can numerically represent "Bezalel" Bezale is a combination of Bezal and Kel, which means "In the protective shelter of G-d." Not only does it mean that H-shem commanded Noach to build the Ark to protect he and his family from the flood and from the people trying to get into the ark, but goes even deeper than that. Bezalel the son of Uri later on is instructed to build the Mishcan (Tabernacle), the House of H-shem May we merit his protection.
